THE GARDEN MUSEUM

Situated on the banks of the River Thames, opposite the Houses of Parliament, the Garden Museum is dedicated to the art, history and design of gardens and is available for a range of corporate events. Ideally located a short walk from three separate London Underground stations, the Museum is a perfect venue to attract your guests and clients, offering them something unique and memorable in stunning surroundings. Whether it's the more traditional Nave or the brand-new Dan Pearson designed Garden extension, the Garden Museum has a space for all types of events.



OVERVIEW

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The entire venue can host drinks receptions up to 250 guests with onsite entertainment. The Nave can hold drinks receptions up to 150 standing and accommodates a screen and projector in-house AV facilities.

The Dan Pearson courtyard garden can hold drinks receptions with up to 100 guests with AV solutions as well. Our evening receptions are the perfect space to style the venue with contemporary furniture that complements the tall, vaulted ceilings in the Nave along with dramatic lighting that accentuates the many features across the venue.

We can also offer group tours for your evening event that explores our permanent collection of around 5000 works as well as our temporary exhibitions relating to garden history and Design.

We also have a front garden that can host guests for drinks, but this space is weather dependent and may require the hire of a marquee at an additional cost.



Standing area across whole site to include Nave and Dan Pearson Designed Garden: 250

THE NAVE

With its soaring pillars, large, vaulted ceilings, beautiful stained-glass windows and the marriage of traditional and contemporary architectural installations, the Nave is a perfect area to host a range of events from dinners and receptions to product launches and fashion shows. Dramatic production solutions are available to highlight the many unique features of the building, creating atmosphere and surroundings that can respond to the identity of your event.


Standing or bowl food reception: 200 guests in the Nave, restaurant and Dan Pearson designed Courtyard Garden only.

50 additional guests in the front garden, however, this option is weather dependent and may require the hire of a marquee at an additional cost.

Seated dinner

On Round tables: 120 guests if a band and/ or DJ. 140 guests if only a DJ present.

On Long tables: 80 guests on long banquet style with DJ and/ or band present with up to 40 evening guests allowed at the venue.





DAN PEARSON DESIGNED COURTYARD GARDEN AND ORANGERY

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The Dan Pearson designed courtyard garden planting is inspired by the long history of plant hunters and collectors – perfectly complements the traditional architecture of the main church and the stunning new contemporary cloister crafted from bronze, copper, and glass. Providing sought-after outdoor space, the courtyard garden is perfect for a cocktail reception before dinner or a humanist ceremony for your wedding reception. Hire of the space can be in conjunction with the Nave or as a standalone space.

THE CLORE LEARNING SPACE



FRONT GARDEN

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



Florists
